

### **METHODOLOGY**

Principal Connections conducted a research programme between 24th July and 11th of August 2023, to investigate the current disposition of the CFO functional role in Ireland. Our objective was to facilitate a comprehensive understanding of what the role of the CFO now means, through capturing the views of those who understand it best. Thank you to each of the 114 CFO's, FD's, HoF's, FC's and others who took the time to respond and inform this largely under-researched area.

The survey was conducted using an online survey methodology. Potential respondents were emailed directly by Principal Connections and invited to participate. In addition the survey was also distributed through social media. Within the email or post was an embedded survey link which brought respondents who agreed to participate directly to the survey. The survey was conducted in line with best practice as laid down by ESOMAR - the European Market Research Organisation and AIMRO - the Association of Irish Market Research Organisations. All individual responses are confidential and only aggregated responses are reported.






#### Q10. Describe the total headcount of your organisation?


#### Q12. In general do you feel valued in your current role?




#### Q11. Describe the total size of your team?




### Q13. Which of the following associations are you a member of?




### Q14. How many hours on average do you work per week?



### Q15. Which of the following best describes the most valuable finance experience that you've gained during your career to date?














#### Q25. Which of the following do you feel will be of most importance to you when considering your next role?


### Q26. Which of the following best describes your current or most recent fixed basic salary?



### **Q27.** Which of the following most closely represents your actual / indicative bonus for 2023?







### **IN SUMMARY**

According to the findings of our study, the following conclusions can be drawn....

- **44%** say that they are members of the ICAI...
- 83% indicate that they feel valued in their current role...
- **38%** say that they work an average 50 59 hours per week...
- 58% feel that industry experience represents their most valuable finance experience...
- 75% say that leadership is the top competency of today's CFO followed by strategic vision (66%) and emotional intelligence (40%)...
- 76% suggest that there is a 'ready now' successor to assume their role should they leave...
- 22% say that to continue growing in their current role describes their long term career ambition...
- 36% say that the CFO's rise to strategic advisor is the trend most impacting their role...
- 79% advise that retaining and attracting talent is the top risk facing their role...
- 46% indicate that advanced data analytics and forecasting are the technologies, solutions and ideas most changing how their working...
- **58%** agree that annual appraisal is how their annual performance is measured...
- 56% keep informed of developing trends through newsletters, circulars and updates from professional services and management consulting firms...
- 32% secured their role through a retained executive search firm...
- 66% say that remuneration is of the most importance when considering their next role...
